

THE UNIVERSITY OF HONG KONG**H.K.U. Engineering Alumni Association Scholarship**

In June 2008, H.K.U. Engineering Alumni Association pledged to donate a lump sum of HK\$75,000 for five years initially to support undergraduate students in the Faculty of Engineering. Hence, an annual amount of HK\$15,000 shall be available for award for five years.

The H.K.U. Engineering Alumni Association Scholarship shall be established with an aim to support undergraduate students who display leadership qualities and show interest in community affairs to participate in activities that would broaden their horizons and enhance the development of their leadership qualities. The Scholarship shall be awarded in the academic year 2008-2009 under the following regulations:

1. The Scholarship shall be known as the “H.K.U. Engineering Alumni Association Scholarship”.
2. Three scholarships of the value of HK\$5,000 each shall be awarded each year to undergraduates in the Faculty of Engineering primarily on the basis of academic merits, leadership qualities and personality, and the candidates’ interest or involvement in community affairs.
3. The Scholarship may be held concurrently with any other scholarships administered by the University, provided that the total value of scholarships received does not exceed the maximum amount¹ stipulated by the Senate each year.

Administrative Arrangements

1. The donation fund shall be administered by the Finance and Enterprises Office.
2. The Scholarship shall be awarded by the following Selection Committee:
 - Dean or Associate Dean, Faculty of Engineering (Chairman)
 - Faculty of Engineering representative on the Board of Academic Awards
 - A maximum of two representatives from the H.K.U. Engineering Alumni Association

The Secretary of the Faculty of Engineering shall serve as the Secretary for the Selection Committee. An interview may be conducted if necessary.

¹ The maximum scholarship amount stipulated by the Senate for the academic year 2007-08 is HK\$100,000.

3. The Dean of the Faculty of Engineering shall recommend 10 qualified candidate(s) for the consideration of the Selection Committee in February each year.
4. The Secretary of the Faculty of Engineering shall inform the successful candidate(s) of the decision of the Selection Committee for the Scholarship.
5. The Secretary of the Faculty of Engineering shall inform the H.K.U. Engineering Alumni Association, the Finance and Enterprises Office and the Secretary of the Board of Academic Awards annually of the name(s) of the successful candidate(s) by June each year.
